Cardiovascular Advisory Panel Guidelines identify normal or controlled blood pressure for DOT medical certification as a systolic value of less than 140 and a diastolic value of less than 90 mmHg (less than 140/90).

If the top number is 160-179 and bottom number of the driver ' s

blood pressure is 100-109, can be put on blood pressure medication and given a 3-month temporary DOT medical certification. Then, he/she must be tested again and if the blood pressure is reduced to 140/90, he/she can be given a 1-year certification and must be re-tested and re-certified each year after that.

The new guidelines stem from the 2017 results of the Systolic Blood Pressure Intervention Trial (SPRINT), which studied more than 9,000 adults ages 50 and older

who had systolic blood pressure (the top number in a reading) of 130 mm Hg or higher and at least one risk factor for cardiovascular disease.

The DOT has issued guidelines on high blood pressure/hypertension, and what steps should be taken to control the condition and determine if you will be allowed behind the wheel. There is strong evidence that hypertension drastically increases the risk of heart disease and that effective treatment reduces cardiovascular illness and death.

Drivers with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes, or kidney disease require treatment if their blood pressure rises above 130/80, since they already have a high risk of heart disease. Can I get a

These guidelines are outlined by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations (FMCSRs). Two-Year DOT medical certification: blood pressure under 140/90; One-year DOT medical certification: a top number of 140-159 and a bottom number of 90-99.

The DOT physical consists of four tests: blood pressure / pulse rate, vision test, hearing test, and urinalysis. As a prospective driver or as a carrier, you should be familiar with these four tests.

Blood Pressure / Pulse Rate. One of the tests is a reading of your blood pressure and pulse rate.

Revised Blood Pressure Guidelines for Commercial Drivers ...

In accordance with DOT blood

pressure guidelines: Drivers with a BP reading of less than 140/90 are medically certifiable for two years of driving. Drivers whose blood pressure is between 140-159 systolic and/or 90-99 diastolic are medically classified as stage 1 hypertension.

FMCSA medical guidelines for hypertension are based on the Sixth Report of the Joint National Committee on Prevention, Detection, Evaluation and Treatment of High Blood Pressure (JNC 6 - 1997). The prior cardiovascular guidelines were based on an earlier JNC report.

DOT Blood Pressure Guidelines | dot physical blood

A driver with a diagnosis of hypertension on treatment should have at least an annual certification. A CMV driver with a Blood pressure (BP) 140/90 may be certified for 2

years. First time BP elevated:

Stage 1 - BP 140-159/90-99

Certification Period 1 year

Stage 2 - BP 160-179/100-109

Certification Period 3 months as

one time certification. Within

the 3 months, if the blood

pressure is below ...

month medical card because

you are taking a medication

and your blood pressure was

above FMCSA guidelines.

And if your blood pressure is

not below 140/90 at the next

examination, in 3 months, you could be disqualified until you do get it below FMCSA requirements.
