the gear stick. When changing gears, you probably don't give a second thought to what's happening behind the scenes in the manual gearbox. But every time you change gear, a selector fork inside the gearbox, contacts against rotating parts to select the gear.

Move the gear shift into first gear, to the left and away from you. Release the emergency, or parking, brake. Slowly ease off of the clutch and give the engine a little gas. Watch the needle on your tachometer. You can completely release the clutch when the needle is between 1,000 and 2,000 rpm. Drive forward in first gear.

Depress the clutch, shift the car into neutral and release the clutch at times when the traffic stops or gets so slow that the car feels as if it is going to stall while in first gear. Let the car roll in neutral and use the breaks to gradually slow or come to a complete stop. Do not "ride" the clutch by keeping it held part way down.
