The routine jobs of yesterday are being replaced by technology and/or shipped offshore. In their place, job categories that require knowledge management, abstract reasoning, and personal services seem to be growing. The modern workplace requires workers to have broad cognitive and affective skills. The Committee on the Assessment of 21st Century Skills was asked to organize a workshop that reviewed the assessments and related research for each of the five skills identified at the previous workshops, with special attention to recent developments in technology-enabled assessment of critical thinking and problem-solving skills. In designing the workshop, the committee collapsed the five skills into three broad clusters as shown below:

Cognitive skills: nonroutine problem solving, critical thinking, systems thinking

Interpersonal skills: complex communication, social skills, team-work, cultural sensitivity, dealing with diversity

Intrapersonal skills: self-management, time management, self-development, self-regulation, adaptability, executive functioning
