El Niño typically lasts 9-12 months, and La
Niña typically lasts 1-3 years.Both tend to
develop during March-June, reach peak intensity
during December-April, and then weaken during
May-July. However, prolonged El Niño episodes
have lasted 2 years, and even as long as 3-4
years.
