Elements of an Essay | Writing Center

1. Introduce the topic of the paper and the thesis statement. (The thesis statement is almost always at the end of the introduction.) 2. State the facts of the case. 3. Prove the thesis with your arguments. 4. Disprove your opponent's arguments. 5. End the essay. Explain the important points of your topic so that the audience can understand the paper ' s position.

The following are important elements of a good argument essay: Pathos means getting the reader emotionally involved in the argument so that the reader is open to further persuasion. One of the best places to use pathos is in the introduction. Ethos - the use of credibility - is also important.
