He then demonstrates how little potency that argument actually has for the claims of

science. In an afterword, James Franklin discusses reactions to Stove's work. This book will be of interest to scientists, philosophers, and general readers. David Charles Stove (1927-1994) taught philosophy at the University of New South Wales and, until his retirement in 1988, at the University of Sydney. He was the author of numerous essays, articles, and many books including *Against the Idols of the Age*, *The Plato Cult and Other Intellectual Follies*, and two posthumously published volumes, *Darwinian Fairytales*, and *Cricket versus Republicanism*.
