In 1981 he acted as spokesperson for the IRA hunger striker Bobby Sands and later coined the phrase 'The Armalite and the Ballot Box' to describe the republican strategy of waging armed struggle and engaging in electoral politics. He was Sinn Féin's National Director of Publicity for eleven years and edited the party's newspaper, An Phoblacht. He was also elected to the Northern Ireland Assembly. He escaped several attempts on his life by the British Army and loyalist

paramilitaries.
