**Annotated Bibliography Example - MLA and APA Format**  
An annotated bibliography is a type of student paper in which reference list entries are followed by short descriptions of the work, called annotations. Annotated bibliographies can also constitute one element of a research paper in fields that require bibliographies rather than reference lists.

An annotated bibliography is an organized list of sources with accompanying paragraphs, called annotations. The purpose of the annotation is to inform the reader of the relevance, accuracy, and quality of the source, and to state how this source will be used in the paper or project.

The only difference is in book identifications format: you write full last name and initials of the author's first name, date, book/article title, magazine title, issue/number, and publisher.
