Extraversion was

measured with the Eysenck Personality Inventory (Eysenck & Eysenck, 1964). In a subsequent replication and extension of this study Gilliland (1976) dosed subjects by body weight (0, 2

---

and 4 mg/kg) and measured extraversion using the Eysenck Personality Questionnaire (Eysenck & Eysenck, 1975) for all of his subjects and the EPI (Eysenck & Eysenck, 1964) for about 75% of them.

Hans Eysenck's controversial career - The Lancet Eysenck (1991) suggested personality is critical to understanding the nature of tobacco use status. Lynch (1995) proposed that the failure of anti-tobacco use programs may have been inevitable by not considering intrinsic psychological factors due to the prevailing assumptions that young adults are

driven solely by extrinsic and social factors when choosing to smoke or not to smoke.

According to Pringle (1996), Eysenck received nearly £800,000 to support his research on personality and cancer. Eysenck's results were a spectacular exception to the general run of negative findings in this field.

Personality was what most intrigued Eysenck, and he conducted expensive

research on different personality types. He was influenced in part by scientists such as Ivan Pavlov, famous for his experiments with conditioned reflexes. But he also placed considerable importance on statistical research. Genetics, too, played a role in Eysenck's research.
