PURPOSE: To inform grantees of the Federal energy assistance program (the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program, or LIHEAP) about the updates to the HHS Poverty Guidelines, (also called the Federal Poverty Guidelines or FPG), which the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Planning and Evaluation of HHS (ASPE) issued on January 24, 2013.

The premiums are made affordable by a premium

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subsidy in the form of a tax credit calculated off your income relative to the federal poverty levels (FPL), also known as HHS poverty guidelines. Maximum Income. You qualify for the premium subsidy only if your modified adjusted gross income (MAGI) is at 400% FPL or below. If your MAGI goes above 400% FPL even by \$1, you lose all the subsidy.

Agencies help families who earn more than the federal poverty level. For example, some programs offer subsidies to families that are 150% of the federal poverty level. For a household of four, that would be  $1.5 \times \$25,750 = \$38,625$ .

**2013 FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES  
(FPG)**

If your income falls below 138% of  
the federal poverty guidelines,  
with your state's expanded  
Medicaid program, you should  
qualify based on your projected

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income. With an income between 100% and 400% of the FPL, you qualify for tax credits applied to lower your monthly premium when enrolling in a Marketplace health insurance plan.

Low-income is considered 200 percent of the federal poverty level, and poor is defined as 100 percent of the poverty level. For 2013, a family of four making less than \$23,624 is considered at the federal poverty level, and \$47,248 is considered low income.
