The FERS annuity supplement approximates a FERS annuitant ' s Social Security benefit at age 62 based only on FERS civilian service, and provides a “ bridge ” of income between a FERS annuitant ' s day of retirement and age 62. At that time, a FERS annuitant becomes eligible for Social Security retirement benefits.
