Another common method of identification is the number line - that 's a line of numbers on the copyright page. Usually, if a one is present in the line then it 's a first edition.

The first editions worth most tend to be those published in small quantities – for example, an author ’ s first books, published before she was well-known. Another example would be a small-press or mimeo publication by a much-collected poet.

A general rule is that if the number 1 is listed, the book is a first edition. But take note: Sometimes publishers include the words “ first edition ” next to the number line, even if the book was on its third printing, according Abe Books ’ website. A number 3 would indicate this (First Edition 3 4 5 6 7 8).
