Statutes & Constitution :View Statutes : Online Sunshine The Florida National Guard shall promptly notify the applicable law enforcement agency of an arrest and the location of the prisoner. (c) The Adjutant General, in consultation with the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission, shall prescribe minimum training standards for such law enforcement officers of the Florida National Guard.

Statutes & Constitution :View Statutes : Online Sunshine Florida law provides for certain exceptions to this warrantless arrest rule for misdemeanors in Florida. Even if every element of the crime was not committed in

the officer ' s presence, if the offense is contained on this list and the officer has probable cause, then the officer is permitted to make a warrantless arrest.
