The basic APA reference page formatting style is to give the name of the author, the date of publication, the title of the book or article cited and the publisher's information. This basic information is used in all citations. When citing a book, this information is formatted as follows: Author Lastname, First Initial (s).

The first paragraph of the reference letter explains your connection to the person you are recommending, including how you know them, how long you've known them, and why you are qualified to write a reference letter on their behalf. Be sure to include the name of the company, job, school, or opportunity for which the person is applying.

In this case, include the nature and source of the cited information, using a term or terms to indicate clearly that no corresponding citation is in the reference list. Place the source information in parentheses (the name of the person and date of communication).
