The first edition of this dictionary, compiled by F.J.M. Wijnekus and published in 1967, was the result of years of systematic collection and preparation of thousands of terms and expressions which were until then not to be found in any other dictionary. Despite the vast amount of research on Italian anarchism conducted over the last forty years, little is known about the history of Milanese anarchists. *Living Like Nomads: The Milanese Anarchist Movement Before Fascism* illuminates anarchist ideas, practices and militants in Milan during the two decades before the rise of fascism. While such anarchists did not prevent the rise of fascism in Italy, they were the first instance of anti-fascist resistance when they stood up against the violence of Mussolini's black shirts after the First World War. Given anarchism's principles of individual freedom, social justice and equality, this insightful study of the troubled history of anarchist movements contributes to a greater understanding of the modern Left.
