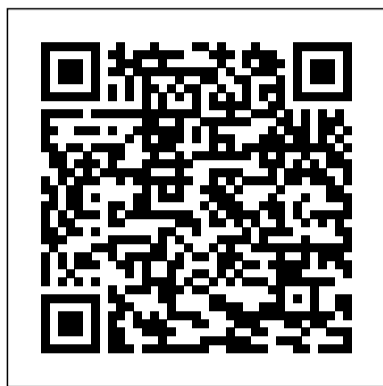

Use forceps to lift the skin between the hind legs and make a small incision with a scalpel.
