with him. Shortly after, he signed to Columbia Records and released his first single and album in 2003. In the following years, he put out various LP's on different record labels and in the year 2012 he released R.A.P. Music. This piece of work received widespread acclaim e.g. from the Chicago Tribune, Okayplayer, Spin Magazine, Pitchfork Media, etc. The song "Untitled," which will be discussed in this paper, appeared on R.A.P. Music and is a rather personal track that touches on different subjects.
