The game consists of 12 multiple choice trivia questions, ranging from easy to devastatingly hard (the latter have been labeled "savage questions" by the hosts). You

have roughly ten seconds to answer each question, starting from when the host begins reading it. HQ's creators suggest this keeps the questions from being Google-able (I've found that they're right.) Everyone who completes all 12 questions split the jackpot. If no one wins, it carries over to the next game. How much money can I win? When the game debuted in August, jackpots were around \$100, but they have since ballooned to regular games for \$250 and now \$1,000. Every once in a while, a game will go much higher, including a recent set for a grand prize of \$8,000. Of course, if you win, you're likely splitting it with other winners.
