The story goes that when Griggs' flatboat froze in at the confluence of the Red River of the North and the Red Lake River, he and his crew were forced to winter here.

History of Grand Forks | Grand Forks County Historical Society

Grand Forks Herald founder, George Winship wrote that Grand Forks owes its existence to a flatboat race down the Red River in the late fall of 1870, in which the team of Alexander Griggs came up short to the Winship crew. The result was that Griggs spent the 1870-1871 winter at Grand Forks and subsequently founded the city of Grand Forks.
