Climate Science Episode 1: The greenhouse effect and CO2 What other factors influence the Greenhouse effect? ANSWER - The reflect heat that comes from Earth's surface that the radiation first encounters- different surfaces will reflect/absorb different amounts of solar radiation -amount of cloud cover- areas with greater amounts of cloud cover have lower amounts of solar radiation reaching the surface of the Earth and also lower amounts of radiation going back to space.
