The diary records the trip from San Francisco to Seoul, December 29, 1885 to June 4, 1886; setting up housekeeping in Seoul; visits to and from various consuls; Owen Denny's illness; unrest caused by rumors of impending Chinese invasion; return to Tientsin (Tianjin), September 3-5, 1886; and visits with consular officials in Tienstsin. The collection also contains an article by Gertrude Denny discussing Chinese spiritualism and religion, and festivals in honor of the dead.
