It is my hope that not even one of these riddles leaves a feeling of “well that was stupid” or “that doesn't make any sense”. They are meant to be written so that as soon as you think of the solution, you are completely sure that that is the correct answer! In case you are unfamiliar with this style of riddle, here are a few classic examples from the “Classic Riddles” section of the book that display the range of wordplay and styles. I don't want to spoil anything so the solution to these riddles can be found in the book!
