Micro-NIKKOR lenses will designate on the lens barrel the maximum reproduction ratio (1:2 or 1:1). Nikon's Micro-NIKKOR lenses are designed to perform their best from infinity all the way down to their closest focusing distances, in the case of the AF-S Micro-NIKKOR 60mm f/2.8G as close as 6 inches.

Nikon F adapters are made for Nikon D-Type and Manual Focus Nikkor lenses which have a physical aperture ring. They Cannot control the aperture of Nikkor G-Type, E-Type or Nikkor PC-E Lenses. This adapter allows you to mount a Nikon F lens onto a Sony E-mount (NEX or full-frame) camera body.
