
Guided Reading Group Activities

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Before, during & after guided reading activities - The ...

Simply put, guided reading is an instructional approach when the teacher works with a small group (up to 6) of students. The teacher is teaching specific skill or strategy to the small group of readers. These students may or may not be reading the same exact text or at the same exact reading level.

Guided Reading Activities This was the station that I was always positioned at. At this station, I was able to sit and listen to every student read to me at least once a week. I would use an instructional text (a challenging level reader) which enabled the students to apply known and newly taught reading strategies.

Guided Reading Group Activities

The activities are age and ability appropriate, for example: phonic game, phonic practise on the netbook, written phonic activity, comprehension task, follow-up task related to their text, reading eggs/eggspress. The children develop their independent reading skills when they are not directly working with their teacher.

Before Reading Activities. As the teacher, you'll choose an appropriate text for the group. Make sure it's at a slightly higher level than what they can read on their own. They should need your help. This is guided reading,

after all. In advance, prepare a teaching point, discussion questions, and (if desired) an extension such as word work or guided writing.
