Some of the new directions for classroom observation research include the following: (1) combining both qualitative and quantitative methods in observation systems; (2) developing observation instruments that are based on "standards" of pedagogy; (3) using student-centered observation instruments that allow for comparisons between groups of students within the class; and (4) using instruments that assess authentic, interactive instructional practices that have been found to relate to student ...

Before Observing. As far in advance as

possible, ask the instructor for

permission to observe the class,

explaining your purpose for observing.

Sometimes, if the observation is for

research purposes, you may not want

to give away too many details that could

affect what is done in the classroom, but

it is still reasonable to explain in general

what your research is about (e.g., " I ' m

studying classroom interaction ") and

what you plan to do with the information.

Classroom observations are prohibited unless scheduled in advance and approved by the building principal. The parent/legal guardian must submit a written request to the principal stating the purpose and nature of the observation. Generally, only one parent may observe a classroom at any one time. 2. A classroom observation is a formal or informal observation of teaching while it is taking place in a classroom or other learning environment. Typically conducted by fellow teachers, administrators, or instructional specialists, classroom observations are often used to provide teachers with constructive critical feedback aimed at improving their classroom management and instructional techniques. Guidelines for classroom observations - McCreary County Informal classroom observation should last between 15 and 20 minutes; therefore, conduct only as many observations in a day as can be followed up on with a postobservation conference either the same day or the next day. Teachers need and deserve some type of immediate feedback.
