inflation of the
traditional
reportage document,
underlining the
growing tension
between art,
fiction, and
photojournalism.
Mosses work
highlights the
ineffable nature of
current events in
today's Congo. Infra
initiates a
dialogue with
photography that
begins as an
intoxicating

meditation on a broken genre, but ends as a haunting elegy for a vividly beautiful land touched by unspeakable tragedy.
