Resolution, in terms of TV hardware, refers to the number of pixels that compose the picture on the TV. A single pixel, or discrete picture element, consists of a tiny dot on the screen.

measured as width x height in pixels. For example resolution 1920 x 1080 means the 1920 pixels is width and 1080 pixels is height of the screen. However your current screen resolution may be less than max supported screen resolution. So you can change your screen resolution from your device settings.
