4 Design Guidelines . C. Basic Preservation Theory. The Concept of Historic Significance. What makes a property historically significant? In general, properties must be at least 50 years old before they can be evaluated for potential historic significance, although exceptions do exist when a more recent property clearly has historical value.

The City Commission approved the new guidelines on Aug. 24. The guidelines were reviewed by the Georgia Historic Preservation Division as the city received a grant from the organization to conduct the rewrite. The grant stated that the historic preservation guidelines could be improved and had to remain consistent with the city’s ordinance, which says the city has to follow the U.S. Secretary of Interior’s standards for historic preservation, Decaturish previously reported.

In order to best protect historic properties, preservation entities that review preservation, rehabilitation, restoration, and reconstruction projects performed on historic buildings must establish and enforce preservation guidelines. These guidelines serve as a clear demonstration of the entity’s goals and intentions as a public or a private steward of the built environment.

Preservation focuses on the maintenance stabilization, and repair of existing historic materials and retention of a property’s form as it has evolved over time. Rehabilitation acknowledges the need to alter or add to a historic property to meet continuing or changing uses while retaining the property’s historic character.
