1.2 An Introduction to Enteral Tube Feeding 1.2.1 Enteral feeding is the provision of nutrients straight into the gastrointestinal tract via a feeding tube, for example a Naso-Gastric (NG) tube or a Percutaneous Endoscopic Gastrostomy (PEG). Enteral feeding can be used as a sole source of nutrition or to supplement a poor oral intake.

Guidelines for Home Enteral Tube Feeding (Adults)

Enteral feedings deliver nourishment through a tube directly into the GI tract. They 're ordered for patients with a functioning GI tract who can 't ingest enough nutrition orally to meet their needs. The feeding tube may stay in place as briefly as a few days or permanently, until the patient 's death. (See Indications for enteral feeding.) ...

Using an enteral feeding pump for bolus or intermittent enteral feeding An enteral feeding pump can be used intermittent, bolus or continuous administration of feeds, but is best suited for continuous feeding when tolerance to rate of feeding is an issue. Enteral feeding pumps can be obtained via CARPS if the ward area does not have its own supply.

Once home it is important that enteral feeding plans are designed to suit the patient 's individual circumstances. This will include the: appropriateness of both pump and bolus feeding. level of support the patient requires, if in their own home.
