Essentially, Question 3 on Paper 2, also known as 'the language question' is similar not only in style but also in markscheme to Question 2 on Paper 1, also a 'language' question. Like that question, it was dogged by poor preparation and an over-reliance on subject terminology at the cost of evaluation.
