article title follows the date. Only capitalize the first letter of the first word of the article, and do not italicize or underline the title of the article. Follow the article title with a period.

Summarize - Write a broad overview of the section or the article in your own words. Quote - Repeat the exact words used by the author using

quotation marks.

1. Start your full citation with the author of the article. An APA citation lists the last name of the author, followed by a comma, then the author's first initial. For some online articles, the author may be the group or agency that publishes the website, rather than a specific individual.

The information required for a journal article, for instance, includes the title and details of where it was published: Author Surname (s), Initial (s). (Year) 'Article Title', Full Title of Journal, Volume Number, Issue/Part Number, Page Numbers. Note that the journal, not the article title, is italicised.
