Start by listing the author's last name and first initials, followed by the date of publication in parentheses. Provide the title of the article, but only capitalize the first letter of the title. Next, list the journal or periodical and volume number in italics, followed by the issue number in parentheses.

### How to Cite a Journal in APA | EasyBib Citations

MLA Style. MLA uses the author-page method for in-text citations. Place the author's last name either in a signal phrase within the referenced sentence or in parentheses at the end of the sentence. Place the page number in parentheses after the sentence unless the work has no page number.

The information required for a journal article, for instance, includes the title and details of where it was published: Author Surname (s), Initial (s). (Year) ‘ Article Title ’ , Full Title of Journal, Volume Number, Issue/Part Number, Page Numbers. Note that the journal, not the article title, is italicised. Quoting, paraphrasing, and citing secondary sources (an author quoted or cited by the author you are reading) in APA style can be confusing. Here are some possible ways to handle it. If you are paraphrasing an author who was cited in an article by a second author (this is the article you read), then it would look like this:

How titles of articles are structured In a journal article APA citation, the article title follows the date. Only capitalize the first letter of the first word of the article, and do not italicize or underline the title of the article. Follow the article title with a period.
