Create an in-place family in a Revit project, or create a family in the Family Editor. See Families. Click Insert tab Import panel (Import CAD). In the Import CAD Formats dialog, navigate to the folder that contains the SKP file.

Choose File Import. The File Import dialog box opens. Select AutoCAD files (*.dwg, *.dxf) from the Formats

drop-down list. For some reason, you have to tell SketchUp what kinds of files you want to import before it will let you select them on your file system.

To join two or more shapes, follow these steps: With the Select tool (), drag the shapes so they overlap in the way that you want to join the shapes, as shown in the following figure, which has three shapes. (See Callout 1.) Select the Split tool ().

1 Open SketchUp. Select "File" from the menu at the top and choose "Open." In the dialogue that opens, locate a file that contains objects that you want to merge. Select the file and open it.
2 Triple-click on one of the objects that you would like to merge. This will select all faces and edges that are a part of that object.

To combine files you can use xref or insert to bring in the model space information. Copy and paste the PS information. To batch plot use the Publish command, pick a pagesetup name and away you go.
