Treat a government document as a book, report, or brochure. If a person is named on the title page, use her or him as author. If no person is named, use the government agency, department, or branch as a group author. Give the name of the group author exactly as it appears on the title page.

Such notations are called in-text citations, and APA format dictates that when citing in APA format in the text of your paper, use the author's name followed by the date of publication. For example, if you were to cite Sigmund Freud's book *The Interpretation of Dreams*, you would use the following format: (Freud, 1900).

APA Style

If you use exact words from the original, quotation marks are necessary. If you paraphrase or restate the idea in your own words, don't use quotation marks, but document the source. In the APA (American Psychological Association) format, one of several documentation formats, you briefly identify your sources in the text of your paper, then give the full information in the Reference List at the end of the paper.

Formatting margins in APA Style is straightforward. The Publication Manual calls for margins to be a minimum of one inch (2.54 cm) on all sides throughout the manuscript. Minimum of one inch: Margins can be wider than one inch—and some university programs require them to be—but not narrower.

To set up the APA template in Google Docs: Open a new document and select File > New > From template. The template gallery will open in a separate browser tab. Scroll down to the Education section and select Report APA. If you need to set up MLA format in Google Docs, there's also a template for that.

Government Documents (APA 6th ed.) - Writing Center ...

When you include the image itself in your paper, it should be properly formatted as an APA figure, with a number, a description/title, and an entry in your list of figures. The title or description of a figure should appear immediately below the image itself, and will vary according to the type of image cited.

APA style requires a running header with page numbers for the paper, complete with title and page number on each page. Find the "Header & Footer" tab under the "Insert" tab and click "Header." Click on "Edit Header." Insert the running title of the paper and click "OK."
