Back to the wallpaper. Once you solve the moisture issue, fixing the wallpaper with glue or Elmer ' s is an easy call...get the wallpaper adhesive. As a painter, I ' ve seen all kinds of things used to re-seam wallpaper; super glue, Elmer ' s, Gorilla glue, Liquid Nails, caulk, and even double-sided tape.

No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair

procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

Place the pointed nozzle of the seam adhesive under the loose edge, seam, or tear and squeeze enough adhesive to coat the torn area. Don't apply so much that it get drippy. Let the adhesive dry for 15 minutes. Some new products dry solid within a few minutes, so be sure to follow the manufacturer's directions.

Apply a selfsticking metal  
screen patch (about \$4 at  
home centers) over the hole  
after removing the patch and  
old paper. Apply two coats of  
joint compound in thin  
layers, feathering it out at  
the edges and sanding the  
repair flat. Since the hole  
repair will be covered by  
wallpaper, it doesn't have to

look as perfect as a regular  
wall repair.

*How to Fix Wallpaper That Is  
Losing Its Adhesive | Home ...*

For loose edges, start by  
pulling the wallpaper away from  
the wall. Continue to pull  
until you reach the point at  
which the peeling ends and the  
rest is still securely  
attached. Next, take a small  
paintbrush and apply a thin  
layer of repair glue to the  
loose piece's back end.

Moisten the peeling or damaged  
portion of the seam. Then  
carefully lift up the loose  
section of wallpaper and, using a  
small brush, apply a thin, even  
coating of wallpaper glue or  
adhesive to the underside of the  
piece you wish to reattach. 2  
Reseat the wallpaper seam. Press  
the piece of wallpaper back into  
place.

the lower part and smooth with a spatula. After drying, you need to go over the coating with an emery paper and smooth it again. In addition to wrinkles, bubbles may appear. The syringe, glue, and towel will help to fill them.

Repair tears in wallpaper by inserting glue beneath each side of the tear using the artist's paintbrush. Rub the glue out with your finger, rubbing gently toward the tear, using caution to not tear...
