Carefully mix with the washing soda and borax (use gloves or a spoon as these can be drying if used directly on skin) Add essential oils and stir. Store in an air-tight glass jar.

How to Make Your Own Laundry Detergent - Making Soap-Based Powdered Detergent Grate the bar soap. Pulse the soap in a food processor. Combine all the ingredients. Transfer the mixture to an airtight jar. Use a small amount of detergent for each load of laundry.

I have been making my own

laundry soap for about 8 yrs. I make a concentrated liquid version that fits in 2 quart size jars and lasts 4-5 months. I use Kirks hard water Castile as this was the most natural soap I could find at the store (and affordable) I do add borax, but may try it without next time.

#### *Homemade Dishwasher Detergent Recipes*

For best results, match the color of the detergent to the color of the glue. You can also use clear laundry detergent, if you can find it. Add in 1 more teaspoon of liquid laundry detergent and stir again. The glue will get

harder, so you will need to press the detergent into the glue with the flat side of the fork.
