You'll be making 90 degree folds in the flattened tube, in a counter-clockwise fashion. Tape the circle so that it stays. One piece of tape connecting the end of the tube to the unflattened section should do it. Tape or staple the tube into the back of the kunai (where the hole is). Make sure the handle is secure.

Make the rubber band trigger and firing mechanism. Fold a piece of origami paper in half twice, forming a long, thin line of paper. Roll this line into a squat tube. Secure the tube with a single piece of scotch tape and trim down the sides to smooth them out. This should look like a tiny toilet paper roll.
