clutch. This pedal appears only in cars with manual transmissions. Tips for Quicker Shifting | Advanced Manual Techniques Recognize when it's time to shift up to a higher gear. When vour RPM reaches about 2500 to 3000 while the car is in motion, it is time to shift to the next gear - for example, second gear if you are currently in first. The actual RPMs at which shifting is required will vary by the car you are driving, however.
