Write an Introduction to explain who the textbook is for and how it should be used: confirm the level of the students e.g. 3rd year

undergraduates; confirm the course that the textbook supports; list any prerequisites or assumptions you have made about the student's background knowledge; explain how the textbook could be used.

Determine a writing goal, including how many days a week you intend to set aside time to write, and set a deadline or due date for when you'd like to have parts of your book. Block off chunks of time to write every week. If you're looking for a place to start, consider one to two hours per day five days per week.
