So if abiding by either of those guides, vou'd italicize Stephen King 's The Shining, just as you would

Vanity Fair and The Miami Herald (and Appetite for Destruction, if your protagonist is a Guns N' Roses fan).

If you have a nonfiction book like a series of essays, or a biography, your title should be more to the point. Fiction or genre stories like horror, fantasy, science fiction, and mystery, should be creative and entice readers to want to know more, offering intrigue. Use words that are commonly associated with certain genres to start.
