The fact that respondents claim that Ethiopia has limited experience in industrialization might explain why human resource management in Ethiopia is contribute to improving Ethiopian human resource management practice. Moreover, this

dissertation may be used as a framework for similar research in other sectors or for more specific in-depth research.
