Massive changes are taking place in society surrounding the delivery of information to individuals and the way they process this information. character is communicated. A socio-psychological perspective is needed to understand both kinds of communication, also to be able to design appropriate support tools. In *Cognition in a Digital World*, the emphasis is on the psychological analysis of interactive and continuing communication and discourse, rather than on the technical aspects of the individual's interaction at the interface. The three main themes of this volume are: \*conditions and consequences of multimedia information processing by the individual; \*socio-psychological characteristics of information transfer over the World Wide Web; and \*analysis of computer-mediated collaborative communication. *Cognition in a Digital World* will be of interest to a wide audience of researchers and students in the fields of cognitive science, education, communication sciences, computer science and the arts (discourse analysis).
