The results are accepted or rejected by means of comparison of state variables (stresses, displacements, natural frequencies etc.) and user requirements. In further analyses the design variables will be updated until the user specifications are met and the design is feasible. This is the primary aim of the design process. On this set of feasible designs, the additional requirement given by an objective function (e.g. weight, stiffness, efficiency, etc.) defines the structural optimization problem. In recent years more and more finite element based analysis systems were extended and offer now optimization modules. They proceed from the design model as defined for structural analysis, to perform an internal adaption of design parameters based on formal mathematical methods. MULTIDISCIPLINARY design optimization (MDO) has developed in theory and practice during the last three decades with the aim of optimizing complex products as well as cutting costs and product development time. Despite this development, the implementation of such a method in industry is still a challenge and many complex products suffer time and cost overruns. Employing higher fidelity models (HFMs) in conceptual design, one of the early and most important phases in the design process, can play an important role

in increasing the knowledge base regarding the concept under evaluation. However, design space in the presence of HFMs could significantly be expanded.
