The application of computational methods to solve scientific and practical problems in genome research created a new interdisciplinary area that transcends boundaries traditionally separating genetics, biology, mathematics, physics, and computer science. Computers have been, of course, intensively used for many years~ in the field of life sciences, even before genome research started, to store and analyze DNA or protein sequences, to explore and model the three-dimensional structure, the dynamics and the function of biopolymers, to compute genetic linkage or evolutionary processes etc. The rapid development of new molecular and

Many of us still feel that computational models rationalizing experimental findings in genome research fulfil their promises more slowly than desired. There also is an uncertainty concerning the real position of a 'theoretical genome research' in the network of established disciplines integrating their efforts in this field.
