Modern Language Association,
which is widely applied in
humanities and liberal arts to
format documents and cite
sources. This style is one of the
most widespread ones. It is
actively used all around the

US, Canada, and other countries for a wide range of research papers written in English.

How to Cite a Website in MLA | In-text and Works Cited ...

The MLA format is generally simpler than other referencing styles as it was developed to emphasize brevity and clarity.

The style uses a straightforward two-part documentation system for citing sources: parenthetical citations in the author-page format that are keyed to an alphabetically ordered works cited page.

sits in the center of the MLA format paper. The title should be written in standard lettering, without underlines, bold font, italicized font, or any quotation marks. Only include italics if your title includes the title of another source.

How to cite a website in MLA. Published on July 17, 2019 by Shona McCombes. Revised on November 18, 2019. To cite an online article in MLA style (8th Edition), the Works Cited entry should contain the author ' s name, the title of

the page, the name of the website, the publication date, and the URL.. When citing a web page or a whole website, there is often no author or publication date provided.

The citation information in the body of the paper itself is called the "in-text citation. " The most obvious time to use it in the text is when you use a quote from a source directly or refer to it by title or author. Generally, you need to list the writer ' s last name and page number enclosed within parentheses straight after the quote.
