Robust FACTS loop-shaping Power Oscillation Damping (POD) controller design in multi-machine power systems: By

applying the model reduction and modern robust loop-shaping control technique, the FACTS robust loop-shaping POD controller is realized. This controller exploits the advantages of both conventional loop-shaping and modern robust control technique. Moreover, it is a decentralized approach and suitable for FACTS controller design in real large power systems.
