In 1903 he became director of the Grand Ducal Museum of Arts and Crafts in Weimar, determined to make it a center of aesthetic modernism together with his friend the architect Henry van de Velde, whose school of design would eventually become the Bauhaus. When a public scandal forced his resignation in 1906, Kessler turned to other projects, including collaborating with

the Austrian writer Hugo von Hofmannsthal and the German composer Richard Strauss on the opera *Der Rosenkavalier* and the ballet *The Legend of Joseph*, which was performed in 1914 by the Ballets Russes in London and Paris. In 1913 he founded the *Cranach-Presse* in Weimar, one of the most important private presses of the twentieth century.
