This study examines the impact of firm-specific investor sentiment on stock price crash risk. Using a large sample of Chinese firms

during 2005–2016, we find that firm-specific investor sentiment is significantly and positively associated with stock price crash risk.

US Investor Sentiment, % Bullish

Where have you heard about investor sentiment? Terms like 'bull market' and 'bear market' are often used to describe investor sentiment. If prices in a particular market are expected to keep rising, investors are said to be 'bullish'. But if price falls are predicted, sentiment is 'bearish'. What you need to know about investor sentiment.

Investor Sentiment in the Stock Market

Investors typically describe market sentiment as bearish or bullish. When bears are in control, stock prices are going down. When bulls are in control, stock prices are going up. Emotion often drives the stock market, so market sentiment is not always synonymous with fundamental value.
