Apple has determined that some iPhone X displays may experience touch issues due to a component that might fail on the display module. An affected device may exhibit the following: The display, or part of the display, does not respond or responds intermittently to touch; The display reacts even though it was not touched

iPhone 5 screen problem How to Fix?

You can do a number of things to avoid it happening in the first place: Making sure your phone is always running the

latest version of iOS. Use auto-brightness to automatically adjust the brightness of the display. Set your iPhone X to turn off the display when not using it. Avoid displaying ...

The easiest way to notice problematic pixels is by displaying different color backgrounds on your iPhone. You could do this by manually downloading each wallpaper. However, the simple way looks like this: 1. Grab a lint-free clothing and wipe your iPhone's display to remove any debris that could trick your eyes. 2. *What to do with a broken iPhone*

Before you go replacing the LCD try giving the back of the iPad a solid smack with your hand. There are many cases where the iPad has been dropped knocking the LCD cable slightly loose. Hitting it may knock it back in place. Do a search on this site and you'll see many examples of this. - iPad 2

iPhone - Apple

Use the drop-down menu or slider next to Resolution (XP calls it Screen Resolution) to pick a different resolution setting. In most circumstances, the best choice is 800 by 600 pixels

or 1024 by 768 pixels, possibly higher if you're using a 19-inch or larger monitor.
