Ensure iTunes 10.5.1 or higher is installed on the computer and go to Store > Turn On iTunes Match. Enter your Apple ID and Password, and you will receive a dialogue box that say "iTunes Match is matching a library from another computer."

To connect an iOS device, go to Settings > Music and you should see a new menu item at the top: iTunes Match. Switch the slider to On, enter your Apple ID password, and then hit Enable. Note that...

iTunes Match supports all the file formats that iTunes does: AAC, MP3, WAV, AIFF, and Apple Lossless. The songs it matches from the iTunes Store won't necessarily be in those formats, however. The songs it matches from the iTunes Store won't necessarily be in those formats, however.

iTunes Match lets its users match up to 100,000 songs from their iTunes library (or libraries) to the DRM-free iTunes Store catalog; these tracks can then be streamed or downloaded to up to 10 of your other devices. (If iTunes Match can't match a track to a song in the iTunes catalog, it'll manually upload it, instead.)

Speaking of audio quality, iTunes Match can help your library sound much better. Any songs that have a bitrate below 256 Kbps will be replaced with 256 Kbps copies in the cloud, provided they can be matched with something of that caliber from the iTunes Store.

Unfortunately, if there is no match found, the original file will be used.

How to Setup iTunes Match on iPhone/iPad Correctly

As Apple Music uploads your music, you can check the status for each song. On your Mac, open the Music app. On your PC, open iTunes for Windows, choose Music from the pop-up menu, then click Library. In the sidebar, select Songs. In the menu bar, choose View > Show View Options. Select Cloud Download and Cloud Status.

With iTunes Match you can unify your digital music library. This Apple service connects your iTunes library with your non-iTunes music and sends it all to Apple's cloud storage, called iCloud.

The iTunes Match service can match most, if not all, of the songs in your iTunes library and keep a safe copy in iCloud. iTunes matches the songs with versions from the iTunes Store encoded in the AAC format at 256 Kbps (iTunes Plus setting), which may be a higher-quality format than the version you have on your computer.

iTunes Match. Remove a song that's been downloaded. Swipe left, then tap Delete. Just show music that's been downloaded from iCloud. Go to Settings > Music, then turn off Show All Music.
